LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Lecturing is in English. Conversational Italian is helpful.

AWARD AMOUNT

The grant amounts to €12.820. This sum includes a maintenance allowance €10.320, a settling-in allowance of €1.000 and a travel allowance of €1.500. The grantee will be covered by Health and Accident Insurance for the whole grant period, provided by *United States Department of State*.
