Scholars may be invited to participate in conferences/seminars at various Italian universities

**LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS**

Italian language ability should be commensurate with project requirements.

**AWARD AMOUNT**

The grant amounts to €10.760. This sum includes a maintenance allowance of €8.260, a settling-in allowance of €1.000 and a travel allowance of €1.500. The grantee will be covered by Health and Accident Insurance for the whole grant period, provided by United States Department of State.
