**DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS OF SCHOLAR:**

Both academics and professionals with previous collaboration with Universities will be considered. Experience with Ph.D. curriculum development and Ph.D. students will be considered preferential qualification.

**GRANT ACTIVITY**

Foster innovation through collaborative research and curriculum development. The grantee will teach an undergraduate course in the curriculum in *Environmental Sciences* (2 hours per week for a total of 20-24 hrs – 15/20 students); a one-week module (jointly with faculty from the Parthenope University of Naples) for Ph.D. students in *Resource, Environment and Sustainable Development* (one week lecture module: 4 hours per day for a total of 5 days - 5/6 students); and act as Ph.D. student advisor. The scholar will have an opportunity to collaborate on ongoing departmental research. Parthenope University of Naples will also assist the scholar in organizing lectures at other Italian universities and Institutions.

**LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS**

Lecturing is in English.

**AWARD AMOUNT**

The grant amounts to €35.500 for a period of 4/6 months. This sum includes a maintenance allowance of €33.000, a settling-in allowance of €1.000 and a travel allowance of €1.500. The grantee will be covered by Health and Accident Insurance for the whole grant period, provided by *United States Department of State*.

**LETTER OF INVITATION**

Candidates are not required to submit a letter of invitation from the Parthenope University.

**ENTRY VISA TO ITALY**

The Fulbright scholar will need to obtain a visa for study purposes (*visto per studio*) for the whole duration of his/her stay in Italy.

**LOGISTIC INFORMATION**

Parthenope University of Naples will provide assistance in finding housing. Office and facilities (desk computer, Xerox, phone, fax) are provided.
