GRANT PERIOD: Either October 1 2010 – January 30 2011 or March 1 – June 30 2011

GRANT ACTIVITY

Teaching one course in the MA program in *American Studies* (Laurea Magistrale) and one course in the Ph.D program in *Iberian and Anglo-American studies* for 4 hrs per week. The average class size ranges from 5 to 10 students. Type of courses: lecture and seminar.

DIDACTIC MATERIAL

Students purchase books; reading assignments are handled also through reading packages

OTHER ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES ASSIGNED TO THE GRANTEE

Tutorials and student advising.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Lecturing is in English

AWARD AMOUNT

The grant amounts to €12.820. This sum includes a maintenance allowance of 10.320, a settling-in allowance of €1.000 and a travel allowance of €1.500. The Fulbright scholar will also receive from the University a sum of €600 to supplement the Fulbright grant.

The grantee will be covered by Health and Accident Insurance for the whole grant period, provided by *United States Department of State*.

LETTER OF INVITATION

Candidates are not required to submit a letter of invitation from the University of Venice Ca' Foscari

LOGISTIC INFORMATION AND UNIVERSITY RESOURCES

Office space and assistance will be granted by the Department of American Studies; the Department library is available for research activities; other libraries in Venice, as the Marciana National Library, offer good research material.

Housing is offered in a university-owned apartment for the duration of the award. Other benefits: access to sporting facilities through the University Sports Center, at staff-member rates; language courses (Italian or other) and self-access language laboratory at the University Language Center, at staff-member rates.

ENTRY VISA TO ITALY

The Fulbright scholar will need to obtain a visa for study purposes (*visto per studio*) for the whole duration of his/her stay in Italy
